

ICE --- Image Composite Editor (Panorama +)

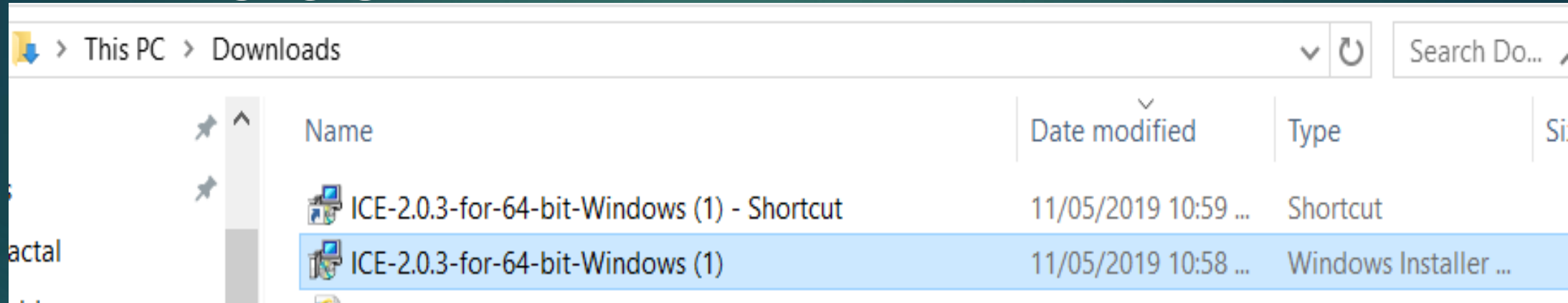

Image Composite Editor (**ICE**) is an advanced panoramic image stitcher. Given a set of overlapping photographs of a scene shot from a single camera location, the app creates a seamless high-resolution panorama. **ICE** can also create a panorama from a panning video, including stop-motion action overlaid on the background.

- Type “ICE download” in your search engine and the above entry should be somewhere near the top of the list.
- Use this web site to avoid being led up the garden path to other applications.

Next stop Your Downloads folder

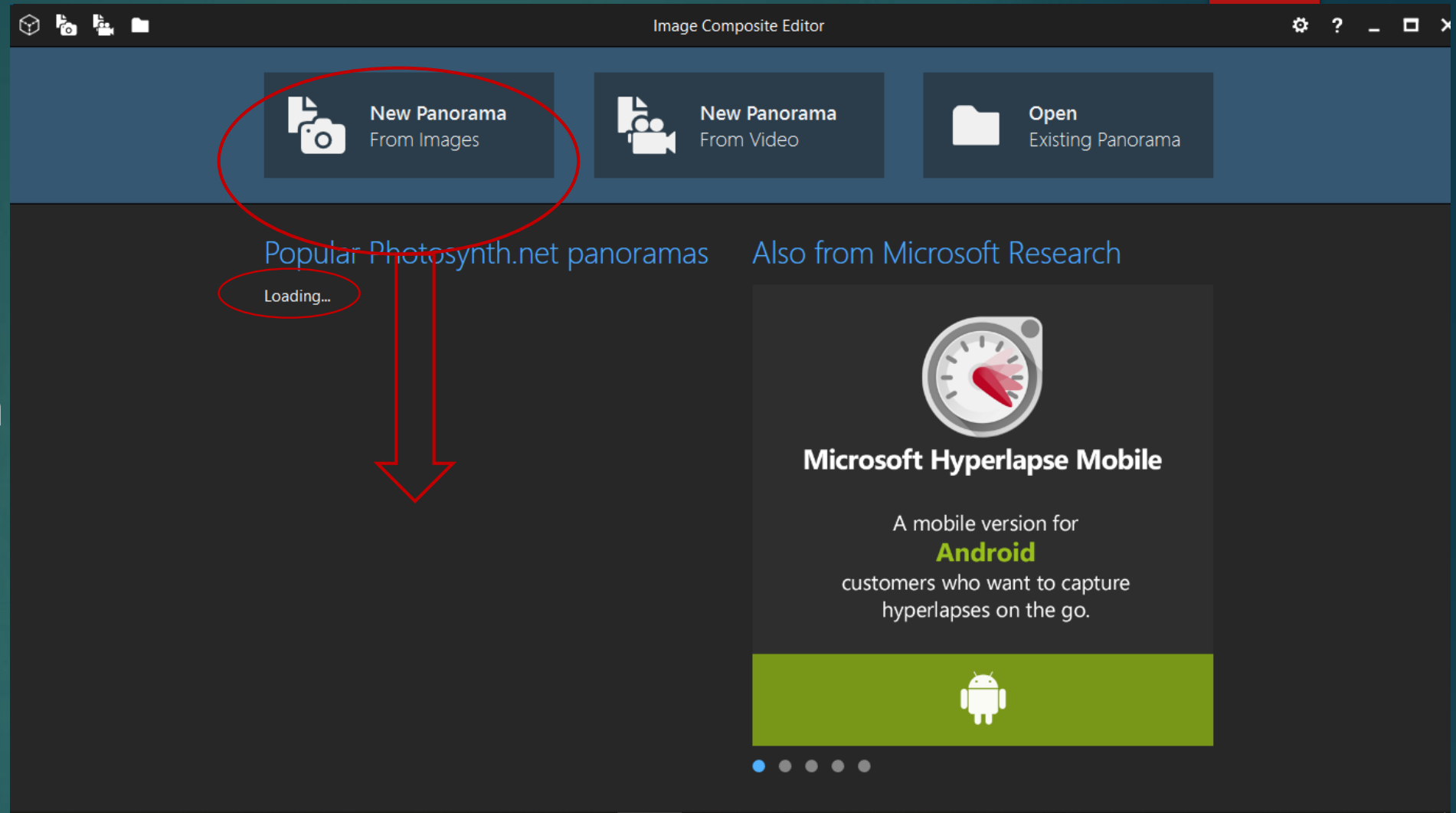


- Click on the Installer to open the file the file.
- Allow ICE to make changes to your computer.
- When ICE opens, right click and select create a short cut on the task bar.

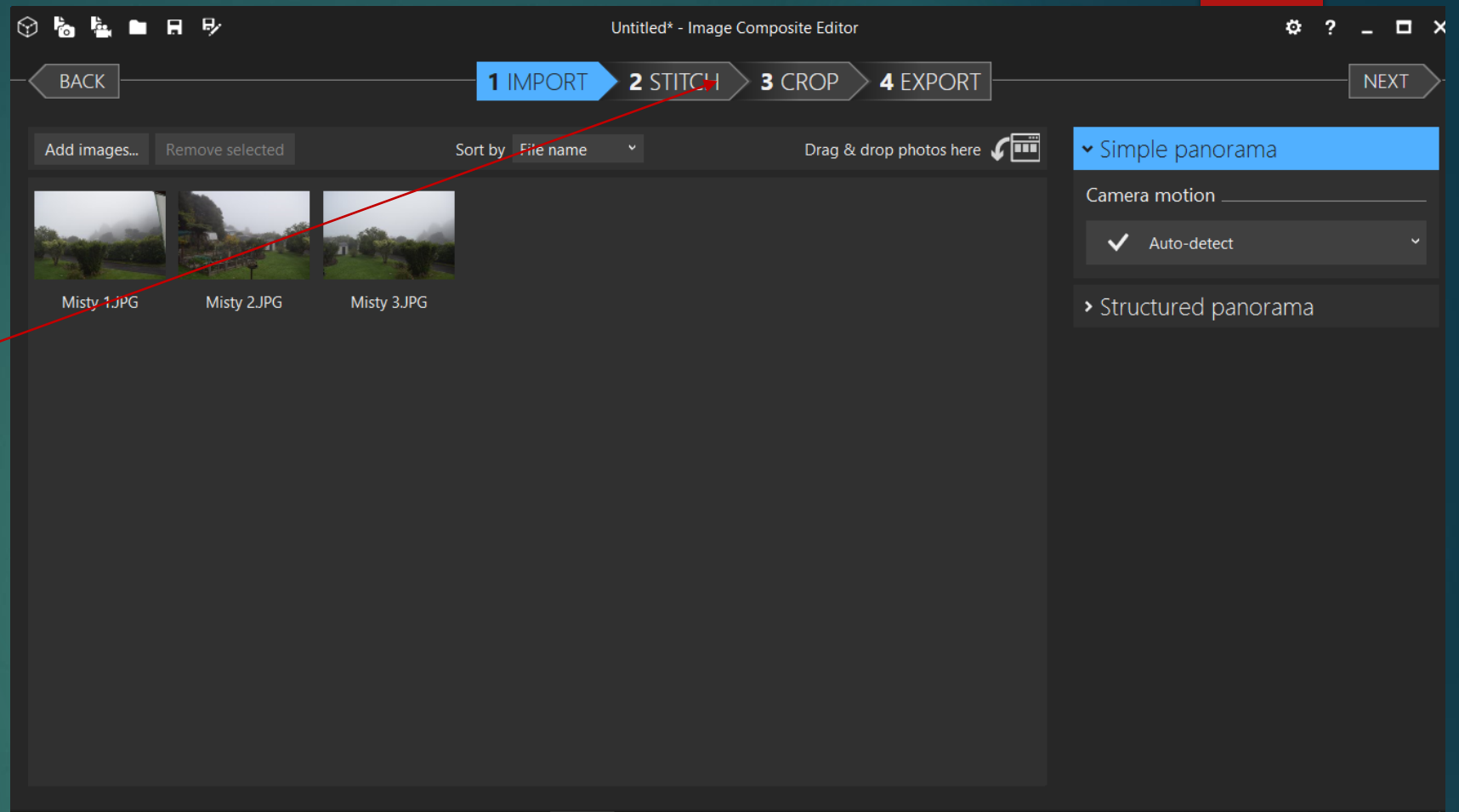


- ▶ In order for ICE to operate correctly you need to have C++ installed. Probably it has been installed as part of a Microsoft update. If not you will be told to install it before ICE will function properly. In most cases you will need the 64bit version.
- ▶ Microsoft ecosystem includes [Visual Studio](#) which is used for developing applications used for [Windows Operating System](#). Microsoft Visual C++ is one programming language which can be used to develop applications in. But to run applications build in Visual C++, users need to install Visual C++ runtime libraries.

- Select your pictures
Ctrl+click on each.
- Drag your pictures from your folder to the left hand space below “loading”
- N.B. Copy and paste may not work

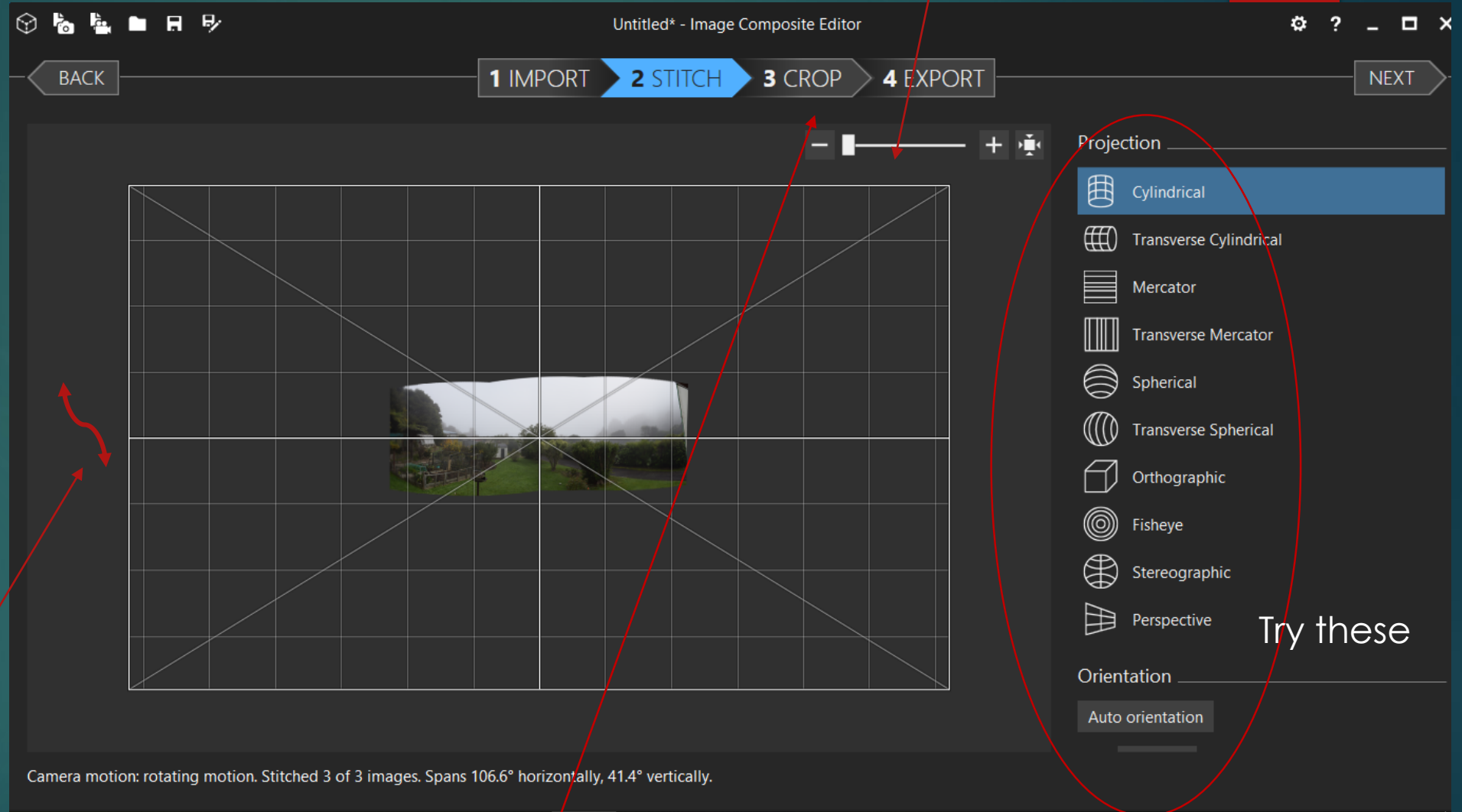


- ▶ Selected and dragged pictures appear here.
- ▶ Click on stitch



The stitching is complete. Note the projection choices listed on the right. In this instance cylindrical has been selected.

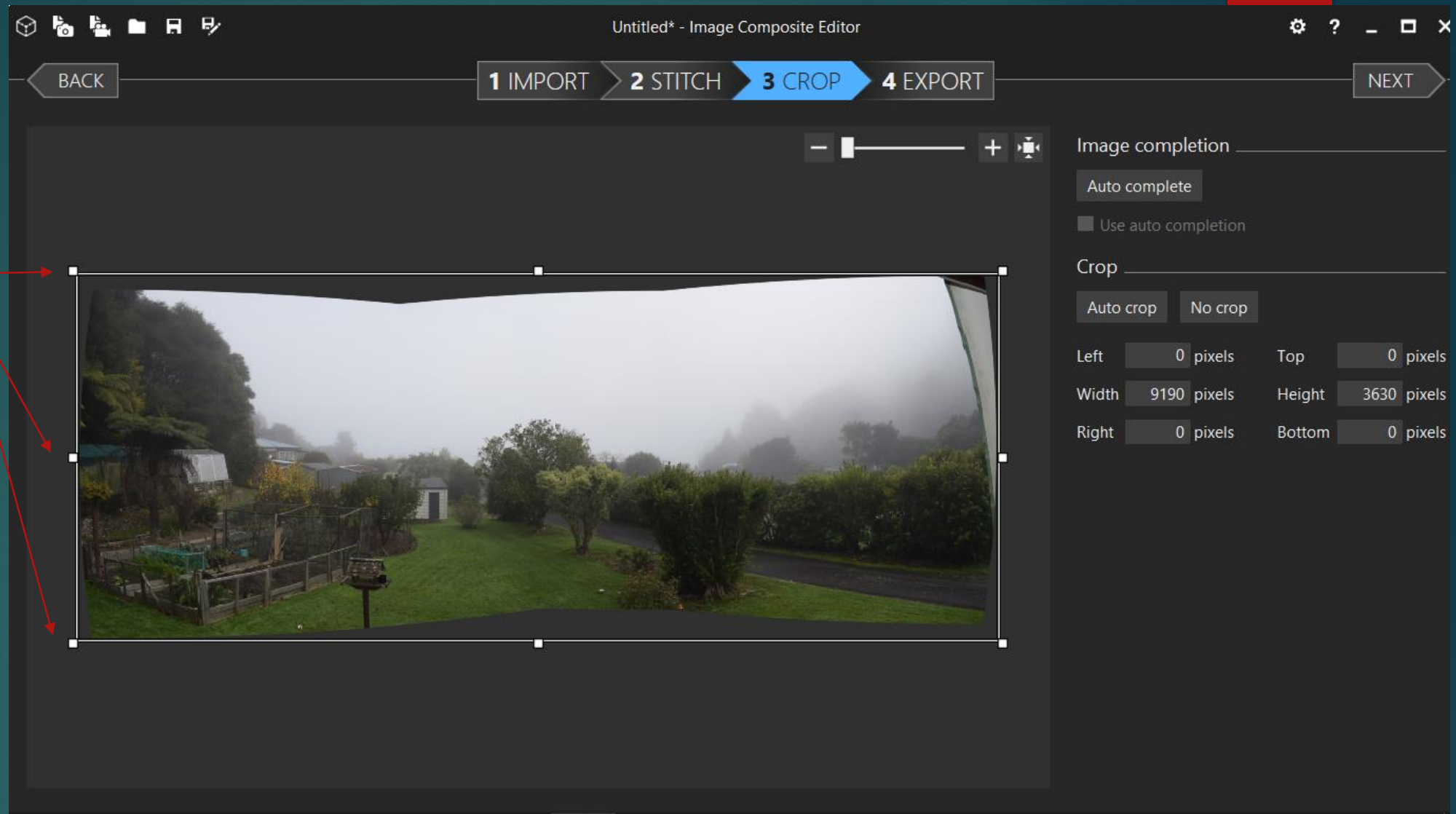
Adjust size



Click for rotate tool

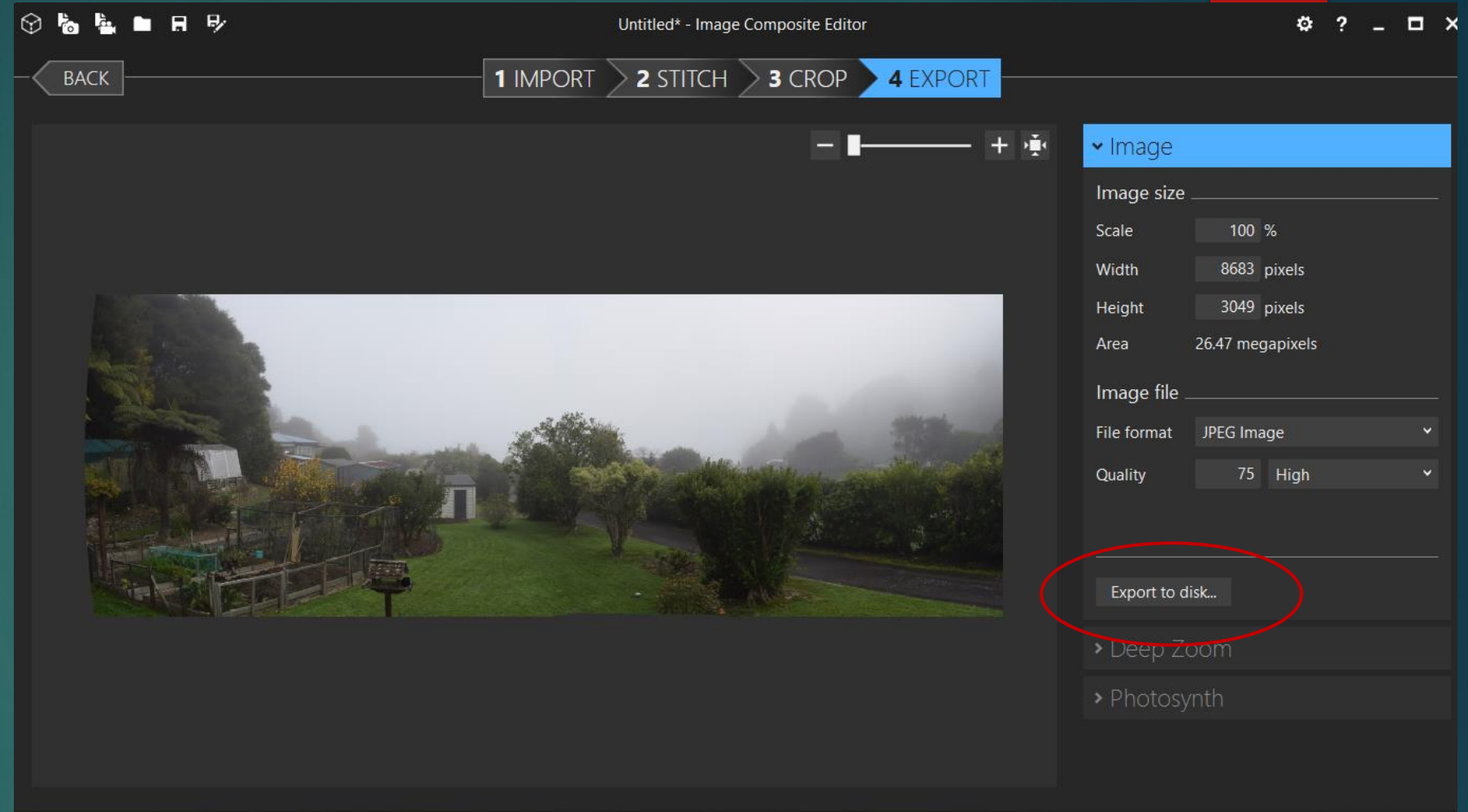
Click on Crop to continue

Crop manually by dragging the dots to eliminate the unwanted blanks or parts of the panorama. Click on

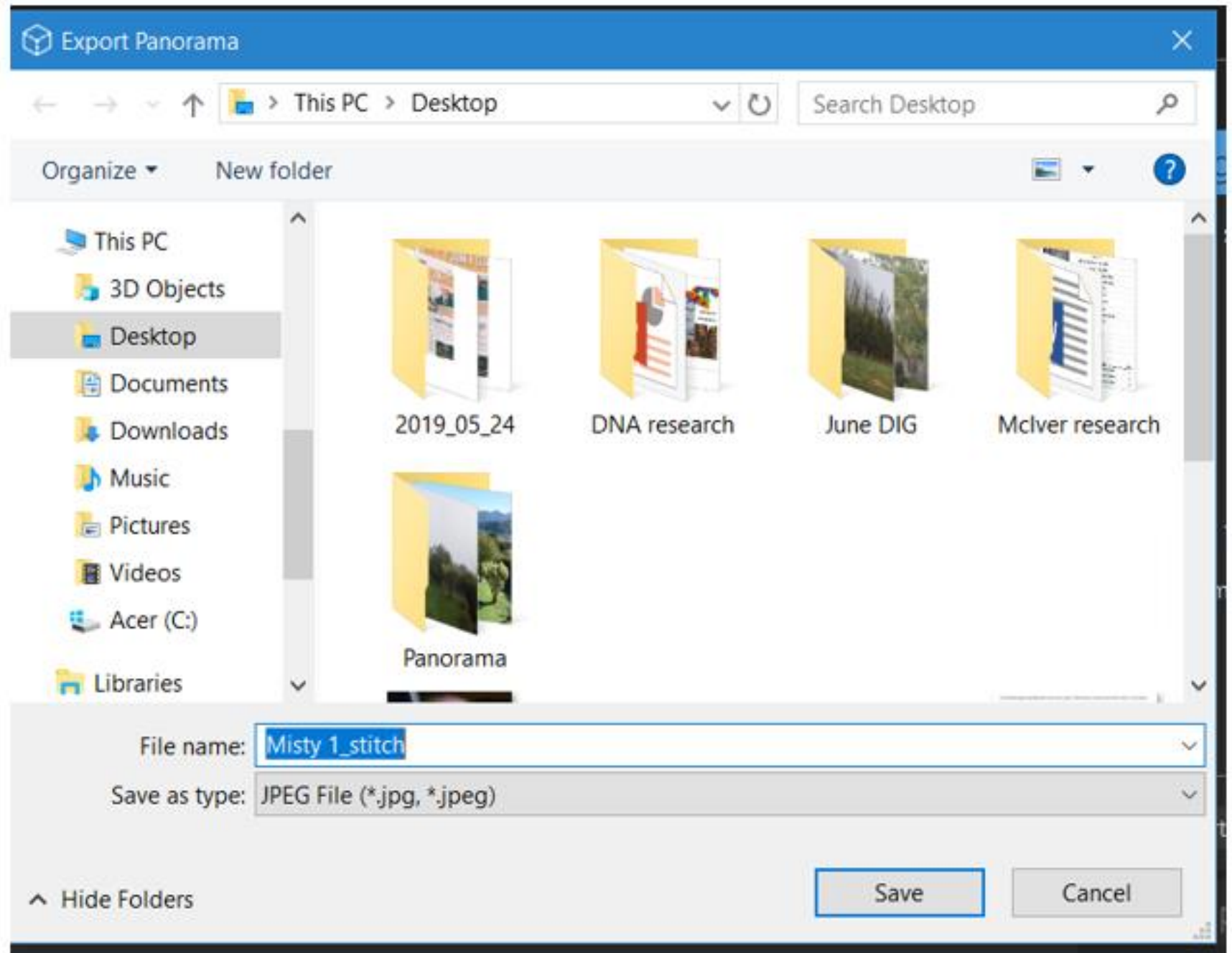


Note auto crop

Select where you wish to save the panorama. Name the file to suit. Make sure you save as a JPEG file. If you save as a panorama file you may have difficulty finding it later.
